1. Read Psalm 119:81-88
2. How does the Psalmist describe his condition? What is meant by the simile “I have become like a wineskin in the smoke?”
3. What led the Psalmist to feel this way? Look at the text for clues.
4. What was the Psalmist’s concern here? Where do we find this in the passage?
5. Why was David concerned about being delivered? Look at v.88. Also, look back at verses 5, 10, 11, 17, and 19. This is just a sample taken from this Psalm, but what does this tell us about his concern throughout this Psalm?
6. How is the commitment of the Psalmist seen here? What *didn't* he do? What *did* he do?
7. How are waiting and hoping interrelated?
8. What enabled the Psalmist to wait and hope?
9. What is the grounds of your hope in time of trouble, or what enables you to wait with confidence as you look to the future?
